~ Dress Code ~

Talent Show:

Youths may wear their performance costumes only back stage and on stage ... not in the audience nor to the ball.

Ball:

The ball is a semi-formal event that follows the talent show. Anyone not dressed appropriately will not be allowed into the first floor ballroom where we will hold the dance.

~ Ladies ~

Ladies may wear a dress, a formal dress (full length or tea length) or a skirt and blouse. The bottom hemline of any skirt or dress may not be higher than three (3) inches above the knee. The top of any slit in a skirt or dress may not be higher than three (3) inches above the knee. Proper undergarments must be worn and not visible.

The following items may NOT be worn to the dance:

Tee shirts, blue jeans, miniskirts, shorts (skorts, Daisy Duke, etc.), backless dresses, dresses with plunging necklines, pantsuits, dress shoes with no backstrap, dress shoes with stiletto heels greater than three (3) inches, combat boots, Doc Martins, sandals.

~ Gentlemen ~

Gentlemen may wear a collared shirt, tie, and dress slacks. Suits or sport jackets are optional.

The following items may NOT be worn to the dance:

Tee shirts, blue jeans, shorts, combat boots, sandals.
